## Obiluary

GILBERT GEORGE Adams was born at 7 Young Street, Spanish Town, St. Catherine, Jamaica W.I., to the proud parents of Mildred Maud Smith and Douglas George Adams on June 07, 1950. He is the first and only child of Mildred and Douglas, but the eldest of eight children.

Gilbert attended Jackson ABC School then at the age of seven, he went on to St. Catherine Primary School, after passing his Common Entrance, he attended Calabar High School. After leaving Calabar High he worked at Water Irrigation Works in Spanish Town. While working at Water Irrigation Works, he met the love of his life Yvonne Wright. They both welcomed their first and only child Tashie Ann in 1980.

Gilbert left Jamaica for the United States of America in the year 1981. While in the state of New York, he found employment at the Goldman Sachs Jewelry factory on 14th Street. He then moved on to work as a Messenger up until the time of his illness.

Gilbert was an avid watcher of boxing and wrestling. He got his nickname "Sentry" because he was always standing unmoving like a guard on duty while hanging out with his friends.

Gilly took sick in the year 2020 during the COVID-19 pandemic. He was diagnosed with kidney problems and placed on dialysis where he had dialysis three (3) days per week since his diagnosis. In November of this year, he went into the hospital because he was having severe pain and was advised to see a doctor as soon as possible. The doctors mentioned he had fluid built up which surrounded his heart. Gilbert had a heart attack while he was at Columbia Presbyterian Hospital; His heart stopped and after the hospital staff worked on him for more than one hour. He succumbed to his illness on Thanksgiving Day at 8:32 a.m.
